

I don't know if this is still the practice or not, but summertime used to be a great time to engage in some extra summer reading. Maybe times have become too hurried and rushed for that. Maybe books aren't what people pick up anymore. But I do think it is important that we pause and rest and relax on occasion. It is necessary for the body and soul to regroup and get ready for things ahead.

That is part of the importance of a spiritual retreat as well: to rest with God. In light of the summer season, have you read anything lately that has helped you grow closer to Christ? While such reading probably doesn't fall in the 'fun' category, such reading and resting is invaluable... probably more so than the constant pursuit of fun. With school on break and recovering from a bum ankle, things have been slower for me. I've done some extra reading, expecially more time with the Sacred Scriptures. Such reading can help remind us of what true resting in God means.

Pope Francis talks about the importance of reading the Scriptures in The Joy of the Gospel (Evangelii Gaudium): "The study of the sacred Scriptures must be a door opened to every believer. It is essential that the revealed word radically enrich our catechesis and all our efforts to pass on the faith. Evangelization demands familiarity with God's word, which calls for dioceses, parishes and Catholic associations to provide for a serious, ongoing study of the Bible, while encouraging its prayerful individual and communal reading. We do not blindly seek God, or wait for him to speak to us first, for "God has already spoken, and there is nothing further that we need to know, which has not been revealed to us." "Let us receive the sublime treasure of the revealed word." [175]
