Having done Mass attendance counts now (as part of the Connected in the Spirit process) for 4 months, the most we typically run at a weekend Mass is about 300. There is space for 375 on the floor of the church. I am concerned about the safety of traffic up and down the very steep stairs. I am also noticing that the balcony is becoming a new 'back, back row' of church. On those rare occasions when the church attendance truly demands the extra seating, the ushers or I will let down the partition. Otherwise, if you are not an organist, choir member, or cantor, please find a seat in the pews on the floor. When sitting in a pew on the floor, please move in to accommodate your fellow parishioners. When we gather, we are all family!

The Connected in the Spirit Strategic Planning Process continues to progress. The Task Force Meeting held on Thursday, January 8 was a huge success (except for the cold). The Core Team members would like to thank those who participated. We felt like we got a good range of clear, concise, high-quality input from the participating individuals of our parish. The results of the evaluation are posted on the parish website. The next step of the CIS process is to start working with the other Core Teams in our Cohort assignment. St Mary's has been put into a cohort with St Rose (Knightstown), St Anne (New Castle), and St Elizabeth (Cambridge City). The initial meeting and training for that is Thursday, February 26 at St Gabriel (Connersville). Continue to pray for the Holy Spirit's guidance as we progress.


