

We are pleased to welcome Fr George McInnis of the Fathers of Mercy to St Mary's Parish this weekend to kick-off our Parish Mission. The Parish Mission will run January 30 through Wednesday, February 3. A Parish Mission is a sort of revival or community retreat. The Mission is well-timed to coincide with the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy invoked by Pope Francis and as we prepare to start Lent in a little more than a week (Ash Wednesday is February 10th).

The purpose of the Parish Mission is to help each of us grow in our personal relationship with Jesus Christ and to enrich our communal connection to the Church, especially in the Sacraments. Jesus loves you. Jesus waits for you. Jesus wants to be in a relationship with you. Jesus desires to pour out His Mercy upon you. Jesus wants you to be a vibrant, flourishing, beneficial disciple in His Church and Kingdom.

I am very excited by the prospect of the Parish Mission. I've been praying for the success of this Mission for some time now. My prayer has been that each of your hearts may be touched anew by the Love and Mercy of Jesus Christ and His Church. Each year, I make a personal retreat. In part, this is required by the Church via canon law for Her priests. It is prescribed because of the immense benefit such dedicated time can prove to be to keep priests fresh and in love with God. It is always a blessed time for me. While the Parish Mission will not be quite the same thing as a personal retreat, it will be very much retreat-like, especially if we approach it as such. As we come to the sessions prayerfully and open to the Graces God would give, we will receive. God is never outdone in generosity.

The High School parishioners and their parents are reminded that in lieu of a normal class they are asked to attend at least the Sunday night Parish Mission Session. For all, there are optional Confessions from 5:30p - 6:30p, and then Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament with Mission Talk by Fr McInnis from 7p-8p. See you all there.
