

The Catholic Church, under the direction of Holy Father Francis, has celebrated the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy over the last year. This has included extra instruction and education in the ways of God's Mercy in our own life and how we are to extend His Divine Mercy to others. It has included pilgrimages to Holy Doors, extra time in prayer, and added recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. This year has included added corporal and spiritual practices to make Mercy tangible in the lives of others. It has included increased use of the Sacrament of Mercy -Confession.

This Year of Mercy formally closes today, Sunday, November 20th in Rome, but in no way is God's Mercy and our practice of mercy to come to a close. The last year was meant to be a sort of refresher course and reminder in God's Generous Mercy. This is a lesson that once learned can never be left behind. It must change us, challenge us, convert us to greater discipleship and love. Having learned well over the last year, we are now to continue to

experience mercy and extend it to others. While the Year of Mercy closes, I am certain it will not disappear from our Catholic Christian vocabulary anytime soon. How could it? For it is Mercy - Love in action to those less fortunate - that first motivated the Father to send the Son through the Spirit to demonstrate the depths of His infinite and immense Love for us in the Divine Action of the Paschal Mystery the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

Now is a good time to pause, to meditate, to examine how have I experienced this Year of Mercy? Now is a good time to recommit to extending mercy to others in real and tangible ways. In this, the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy can serve as a guide. There are seven of each, perhaps to encourage us to one spiritual and one corporal work of mercy each day of the week. Corporal Works: feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, shelter the homeless, visit the sick, visit the imprisoned, and burying the dead. Spiritual Works: Admonish the sinner, instruct the ignorant, counsel the doubtful, comfort the sorrowful, bear wrongs patiently, forgive injury, and Pray for the living and the dead. Happy and Blessed Thanksgiving.
