

Gaudete Sunday – Third Sunday of Advent – is a small moment of rejoicing in the midst of our Advent preparations. We light the "pink" candle and I get the opportunity to wear once again the parish's new Gaudete/Laetare "rose" vestment. A special thanks to the St Mary Sodality for providing the new vestment for the parish. It is lovely.

In a special way, St Mary parish can rejoice ("Gaudete") in **Joe Hoffman**. Joe has been attending St Mary's for several years. After much prayer, private catechesis, and preparation, he is excited to be received into Full Communion

with the Catholic Church this Saturday at the 5:30p Mass.
