Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity!

Few mysteries of the Faith are as central and profound as the Trinity. The fact that God is One God in Three Persons and Three Persons in One God is challenging to comprehend. The revealed truth of the Holy Trinity is at the very root of the Church's living faith as expressed in the Creed. The mystery of the Trinity in itself is inaccessible to the human mind and is the object of faith only because it was revealed by Jesus Christ, the divine Son of the Eternal Father.




Over the Baptismal Font of our church, you will see the Mystery of the Trinity ensconced in the stained glass window (see above). Presented in Latin abbreviations, there is the Mystery of the Trinity. Around the perimeter: P(ater) non est F(ilius). P non est SS (Spiritus Sanctus). F non est SS. [Father is not the Son. Father is not the Holy Spirit. Son is not the Holy Spirit.] And on the 'spokes': P/F/SS est D(eus). Father/Son/Holy Spirit is God. This visual representation of the Mystery of the Trinity is found in many Catholic Churches... if you have an eye to look for it in the windows or Sacred Art.



In the Archdiocese, the first Sunday of June is reserved annually on priest's calendars for the Ordination Mass of new priests. Last Saturday, June 3, there was no such Mass of Ordination. We added no new priests to the Archdiocesan presbyterate. Sometimes this is known as a 'zero-year.' It is always a sad affair. In this same year, we have three senior priests taking retirement from active ministry due to age and health. As I have commented before, priests don't come from somewhere else. They need to come from here in our parish. During this 'zero-year,' parishes from the Connersville deanery and other parishes around the Archdiocese will be uniting in extra prayers for Priestly vocations at the end of each Mass. You

can find the words to the prayer on the back of your hymnals. Feel free to pray the prayer on your own anytime. Please pray for priests. Please encourage your sons, grandsons, or parishioner's sons. The call must come from God, but if it is not echoed in the family and parish, it will go unheard.
