Thank you to those parishioners who volunteered with the **Parish Work Day** on Saturday (6/11). We completed several projects around the parish campus. It was a great time to socialize and work alongside fellow parishioners to take care of our home away from home. Many hands make light work.

This week, the parish is expecting nearly 25 young children for **Vacation Bible School (VBS)** from Preschool to 6th grade. Ms. Jill Kuntz (ARE) and a team of volunteers will present a Biblical presentation of the Luminous Mysteries of the Rosary – Catholic and Scriptural!!! It should be a great time for our little ones. The VBS students will also be joining the weekday Mass this coming Friday, June 17, which is why Mass that day will start at 9am (not 8:30am).



Speaking of the Rosary, can you name the five **Luminous Mysteries** instituted by Saint Pope John Paul II in October of 2002? These mysteries highlight some of the pivotal moments of Jesus' life and ministry. The Luminous Mysteries are traditionally prayed on Thursdays (Joyous on Monday/Saturday; Sorrowful on Tuesday/Friday; Glorious on Wednesday/Sunday). Ok... so the Five Luminous Mysteries are: 1) the Baptism of Lord Jesus, 2) the Wedding Feast of Cana, 3) the Proclamation of the Kingdom, 4) the Transfiguration of the Lord, and 5) the Institution of the Eucharist. The Rosary is Scriptural, is spiritual, is sanctifying. A devout praying of the Rosary draws us into the great Mystery of Christ's work of salvation through the intercession of Our Lady. It forms us for faithful discipleship. Pick up your Rosary and pray it!
