Has this ever happened to you? Someone notices the crucifix around your neck or that you make the Sign of the Cross before eating, and they say, ‘You’re Catholic? Why do you Catholics...’ To which you answer, “uhhhh, I’m not sure. I’d need to ask father.” For those raised in the Faith, we often practice without full understanding. We grow up in it, and as such, fail to grasp the tremendous riches and blessings of our divine inheritance!

What are we to do? **First, pray!** Our communal prayer in the Mass, sustained by our personal prayer, will open us up to the Holy Wisdom of God. Prayer is essential to developing your intellectual knowledge.

Second is study! When one falls in love with another – as we do with Christ, we want to know all about the other, about our Lord and His Body, the Church. St Mary has renewed its annual subscription to a perfect resource for study and learning. It is free and available to everyone in Rush County. The resource is called **FORMED**. This on-line resource is a kind of ‘Catholic Netflix.’ FORMED provides four main categories of resources: Study Programs, Movies, Audio talks, and eBooks. All of the content is completely orthodox and sound. It is produced by some of the most prominent names in Catholic Evangelization, Apologetics, Catechetics, and Christian entertainment today. New content is regularly added. There are resources for all age levels from children to elders of the parish across a spectrum of topics.

Ninety-nine parish households already have Formed accounts (Yes, I can see who!). This is 20% of our families. **I’d like to make a goal of DOUBLING this number in the coming year.** Engaging in personal enrichment is not an ‘extra’ but the norm of Christian discipleship. It is my fervent prayer and active work to help you build a living, lively, loving relationship with Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church. Such a relationship makes my task of ‘saving souls’ much easier, as this is the prerequisite to being a saint! I invite you to log in today and start diving deeper into your faith. Also, feel free to share this information with others, especially non-Catholics. They too will definitely get their questions answered.

This week, we celebrate the feast days of St. Ignatius of Loyola (8/31), St Alphonsus Liguori (9/1), and St John Vianney (9/4). Each of these saints spent their lives in service to Christ through service to the people of the Church, especially by educating the faithful and enabling a relationship with Jesus. May they intercede for us as we too grow in our faith.


