Family Formation for Kindergarten to Sixth Grade

“Parents, you have asked to have your child baptized. In doing so, you are accepting the responsibility of training him/her in the practice of the faith. It will be your duty to bring him/her up to keep God's commandments as Christ taught us, by loving God and our neighbor.” (Baptismal Rite, 77)

Procedure:

1. **Attend** Parent-Child Session on Sunday. Parent(s) will meet with Fr Gries to go over the materials to help answer questions and resource the parents to fulfill their responsibility as primary catechist to your children. Children will go to breakout session with parish catechist to receive faith formation.
2. **Take-Home** Monthly Session Packets from the First Sunday session. Parents should look through packets.
3. **Schedule** Faith Formation Time for family. It is recommended that this is set for the same time each week, perhaps on Sunday to help sanctify the Lord's Day. A set day and time makes it more likely you will do it. If and when those rare conflicts arise, schedule an alternate time for your family.
4. **Meet** as a family to work through that week's Faith Formation Session. They are related to the Sunday Mass readings, so you can discuss and tie in the Faith Formation with Mass.
